THE DIONISIUS A. AGIUS BOOK PRIZE 2019

The Society for the Medieval Mediterranean offers the *Dionisius A. Agius Prize* biennially for a distinguished first book in the field of Medieval Mediterranean Studies.

To be eligible for consideration for the prize, the book must:

1. *Be on a subject related to the history, society or culture of the Medieval Mediterranean, from the fifth to the fifteenth centuries CE;*
2. *Be its author's first solely written book;*
3. *Be published in English;*
4. *Have been printed in 2017 or 2018.*

Winners will receive a prize of £700, together with publicity in both *Al-Masāq: the Journal of the Medieval Mediterranean* and on the Society's website. The publisher or the author should present an entry form for each book submitted, together with one copy of the eligible book by **31st January 2019**. Entries will not be returned. Should the book be short-listed, two further copies will be requested.

The prize winner will be announced at the Society's conference to be held at the Institute of Catalan Studies of Barcelona, organised in collaboration with the Institut Milái Fontanals/CSIC on 8-11th **July 2019**.
